- After critique, report to homeroom to hang up costumes before doing anything else (a chaperone must check and approve your costume when you hang it up. Don't cut corners!)

4:30 p.m. Watch VA in Auditorium

5:30 p.m. Daytime Awards (Auditorium)

7:15 p.m. Finals begin

10:00 p.m. Final Awards (Auditorium)

Arrive Home:

Approximately 2:00 a.m. (subject to change due to the many factors involved)

TO BRING:

Women - character shoes, nude color hose, corset, make-up, hair products. Reminder: No colored nail polish or jewelry.

Men - Shoes, black socks (make sure they're tall enough), dark compression shorts, hair products as needed.

Band - All black dress clothes, folder w/ music, horn/equipment - double and triple check!

Reminders:

- Trailer loading/unloading: please help load the trailer on Friday after school if you are available. Many hands make light work. EVERYBODY is required to unload the trailer Saturday night
- Students are required to ride school transportation to and from show choir events and are not permitted to leave campus without permission for any reason; stay with the group! A note/email is required if you plan to ride home with a parent and not on the bus.
